**DATES OF CONTRACT:**

This contract is for two semesters: Fall semester, August 31, 2009 through December 22, 2009, and Winter semester, January 11, 2010 through May 4, 2010.

**PLEASE SELECT A DINING PLAN (check one)**

Freshmen student residents living in Atchison and Ghafari Halls must select either the 19 meals per week dining plan or the 15 meals per week dining plan. Undergraduate student residents living in The Towers must select one of the following: 19, 15, 10 or 5 meals per week dining plan. Graduate student residents of The Towers may select any dining plan.

\_\_\_\_\_ **19 Meals per Week: \$2,580 for two semesters. Meals can be used in any of the 23 meal periods per week. Unused meals do not roll over from week to week.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **15 Meals per Week: \$2,850 for two semesters. Meals can be used in any of the 23 meal periods per week. Unused meals do not roll over from week to week. \$100 in Warrior Dollars also provided each semester.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **10 Meals per Week: \$2,370 for two semesters. Meals can be used in any of the 23 meal periods per week. Unused meals do not roll over from week to week. \$50 in Warrior Dollars also provided each semester.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **5 Meals per Week: \$1,340 for two semesters. Meals can be used in any of the 23 meal periods per week. Unused meals do not roll over from week to week. \$25 Warrior Dollars also provided each semester.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **Super 78: \$1,080 for two semesters. Any 78 meals during each semester for self and guests.**

**CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS AND CHANGES**

I understand this contract may not be cancelled earlier than the two semester periods specified above except for verified withdrawal from the University or as otherwise provided in this paragraph or on the back page of this contract. Cancellations may also be granted to students who are participating in University-sponsored study abroad and co-op programs. I may request an exception to cancel this contract through the Director of Housing and Residential Life, or his/her designee. Failure to use a dining plan or failure to make payment does not cancel my financial obligation. I understand that the only changes permitted to the dining plan are outlined on the reverse page of this contract in the "Change Policy" section.

I further agree to abide by all rules and regulations established by the Office of Housing and Residential Life. I understand that this contract goes into effect upon being signed by a representative of the Office of Housing and Residential Life. ## **2009-2010 RESIDENTIAL DINING PLAN CONTRACT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

### **DATES OF CONTRACT:**

This is a two-semester contract; Fall semester, August 31, 2009 to December 22, 2009 and Winter semester, January 11, 2010 through May 4, 2010.

### **MEAL PLAN WEEK:**

The number of meals purchased per week can be used anytime during the meal plan week which begins with Breakfast on Monday and ends with Dinner on Sunday. There are 23 meal periods in each week: Monday-Thursday Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner and Late Night; Friday Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner; Saturday and Sunday, Brunch and Dinner.

### **MEAL SCHEDULE DURING HOLIDAY AND UNIVERSITY CLOSURE:**

Labor Day, Monday, September 7, 2009: Only Brunch and Dinner meals will be served .

Thanksgiving Closure: Meal service ends and Meal Plans will be suspended after lunch on Wednesday, November 25, 2009 and will restart on Monday, November 30, 2009 with the service of Breakfast.

Fall Semester Closure: Meal service ends and Meal Plans will be suspended after Dinner on Tuesday, December 22, 2009 and will restart for the Winter Semester on Monday, January 11, 2010 with the service of Breakfast.

Spring Break Closure: Meal service ends and Meal Plans will be suspended after Dinner on Friday, March 12, 2010 and restart on Monday, March 22, 2010 with Breakfast.

Winter Semester Closure: Meal Plans end after Dinner on Tuesday, May 4, 2010.

### **POLICIES:**

\*All first-year students must select **either** the 19 meals per week plan **or** the 15 meals per week plan. Upperclass student residents of The Towers must select one of the following plans: 19 meals per week, 15 meals per week, 10 meals per week or 5 meals per week. Graduate students living in The Towers must select a meal plan from any that are offered.

\*The purchase of any meal plan is for two semesters and is billed by semester.

\*The 15 meals per week plan, 10 meals per week plan and 5 meals per week plan also come with Warrior Dollars. Warrior Dollars are a flexible declining balance account allotted on a per semester basis, however the dining contract is for two semesters.

\*Allotted Warrior Dollars remaining on any meal plan at the end of the Fall Semester do not roll forward to the Winter Semester. All meal plans and Warrior Dollars expire at the end of Winter Semester.

\*Only one meal may be used per meal period. All offered meal plans except the 19 meals per week plan allow for one guest pass during a lunch period once per week.

\*Meal plans and Warrior Dollars are encoded on the Wayne State University ID Card, which must be presented to enter a residential dining facility or use Warrior Dollars at other participating campus food vendors.

\*At the discretion of Housing and Residential Life, locations where Warrior Dollars are accepted may change during the year.

\*At the discretion of Housing and Residential Life, dining locations and hours may vary.

\*First-year students must complete and submit this contract by June 30, 2009 to Housing and Residential Life, Wayne State University, 5221 Gullen Mall, SCB 598, Detroit, Michigan 48202. If we do not have your contract on record by that date, then you will automatically be placed on the 19 meals per week plan. You may be able to change your meal plan, if you wish, consistent with the change policy.

### **CHANGE POLICY:**

\*Meal plan participants may not change this contract to a lower number of meals per week. Meal plan changes to increase the number of meals purchased per week can be made at any time in the Office of Housing and Residential Life, 598 Student Center Building.

\*All applicable paperwork must be submitted to the Housing and Residential Life office for any proposed change in a meal plan.
